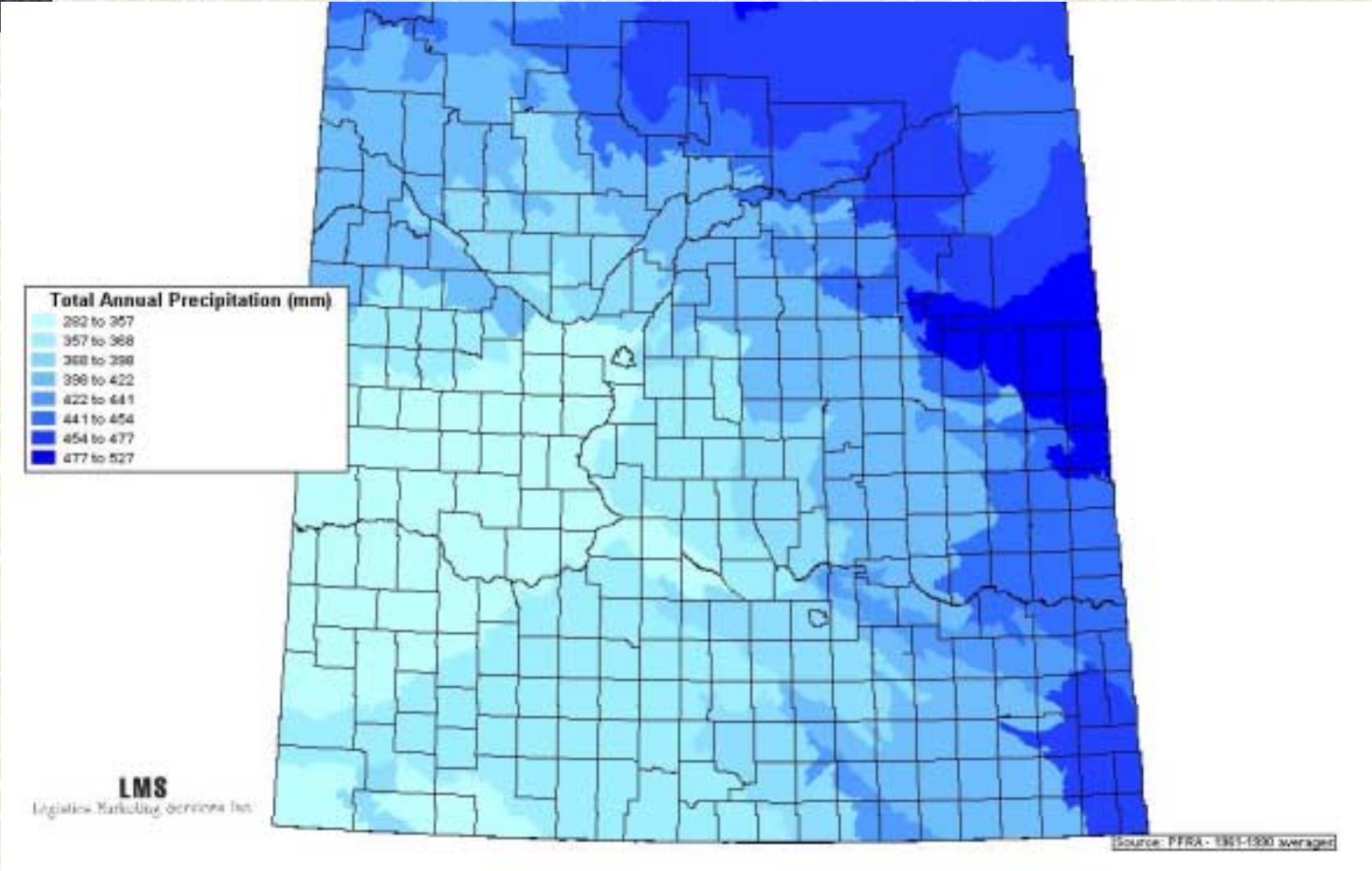

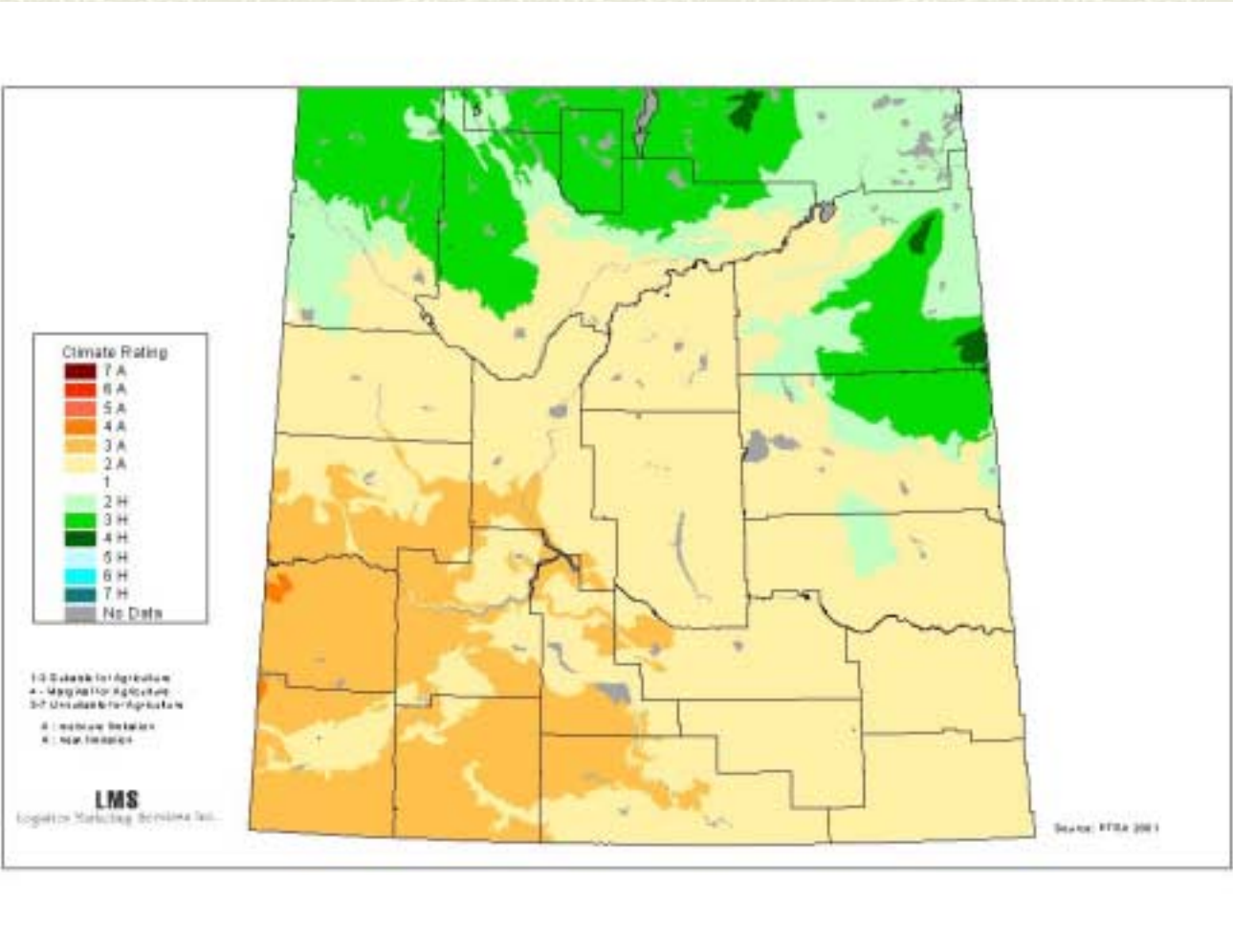

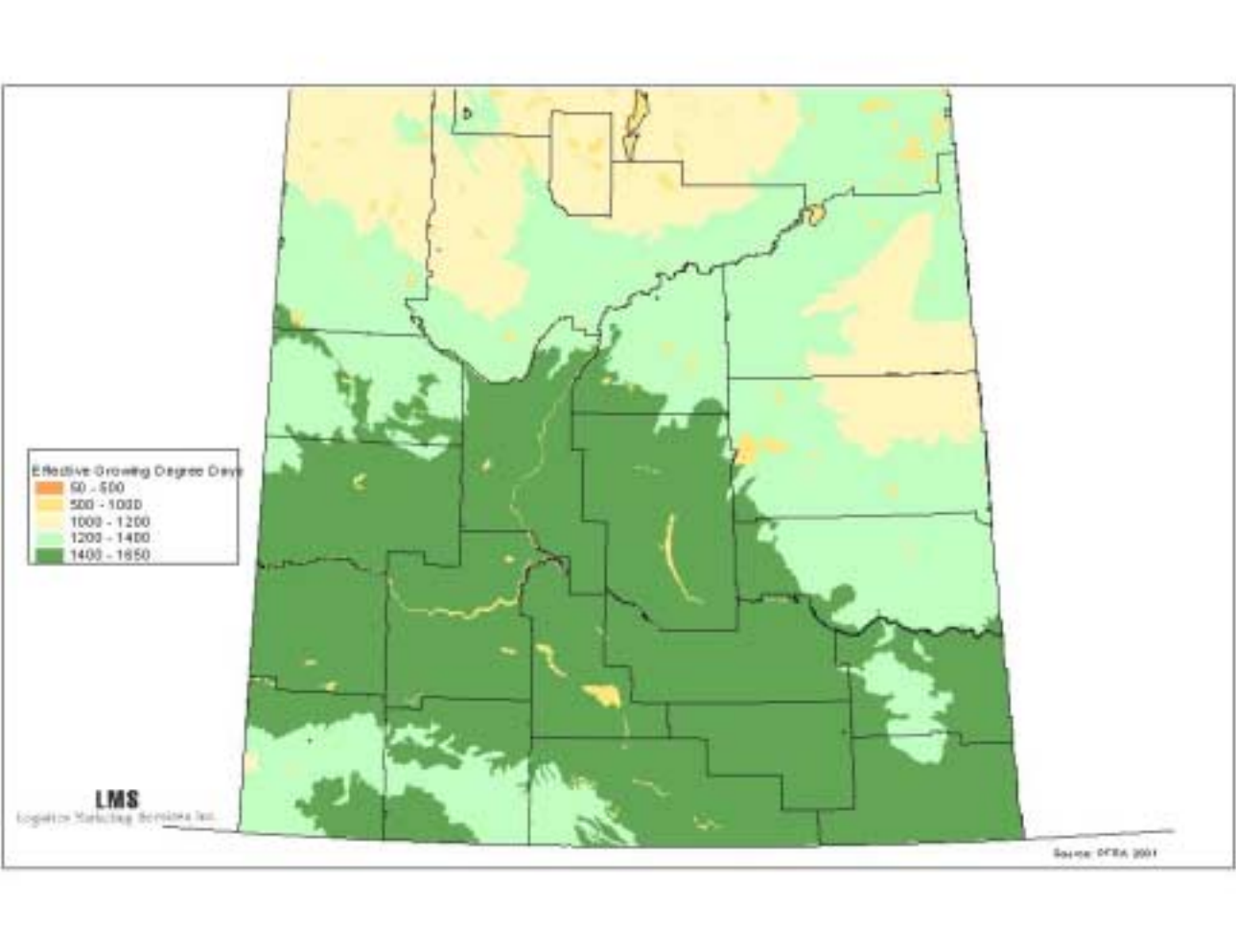

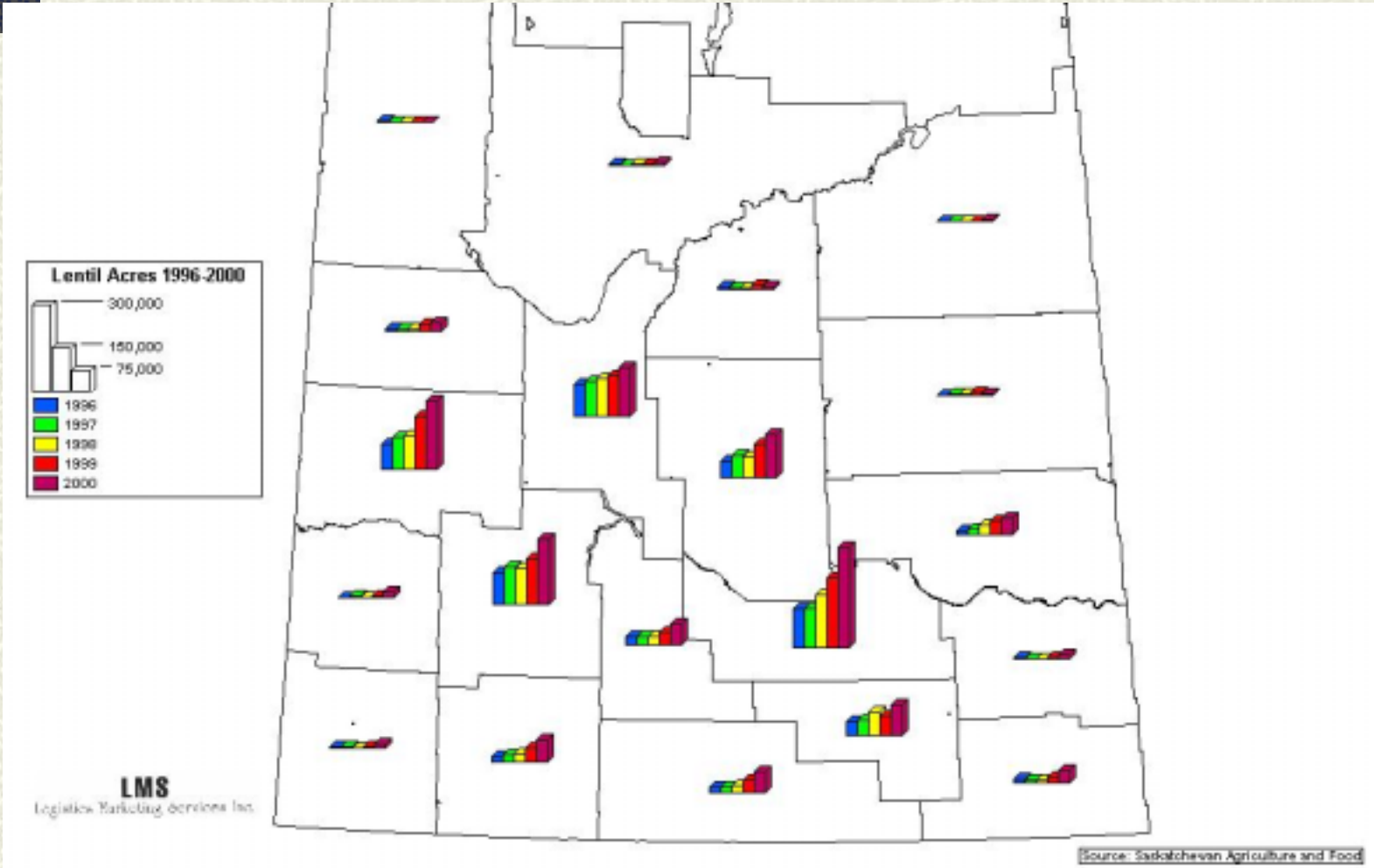

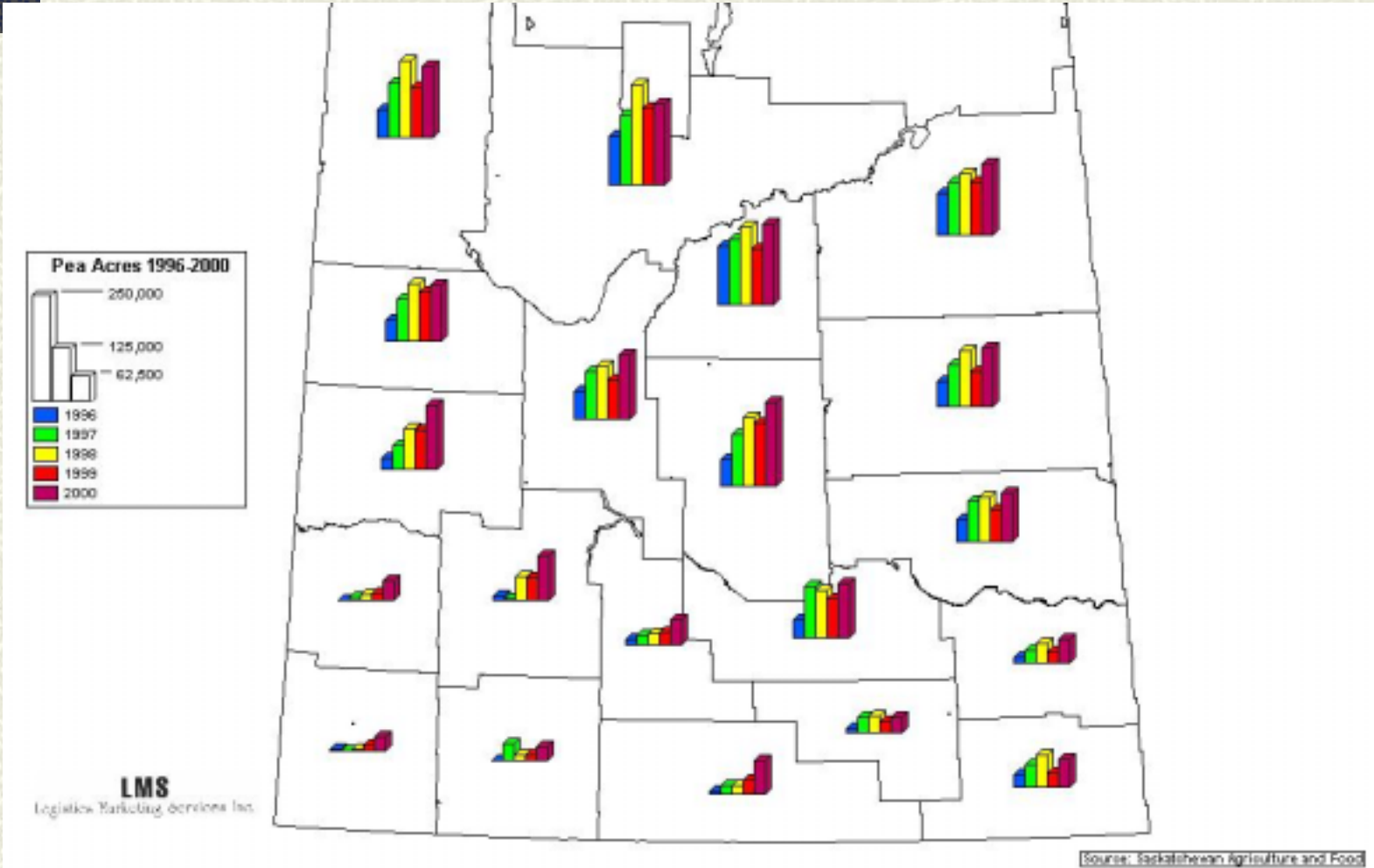

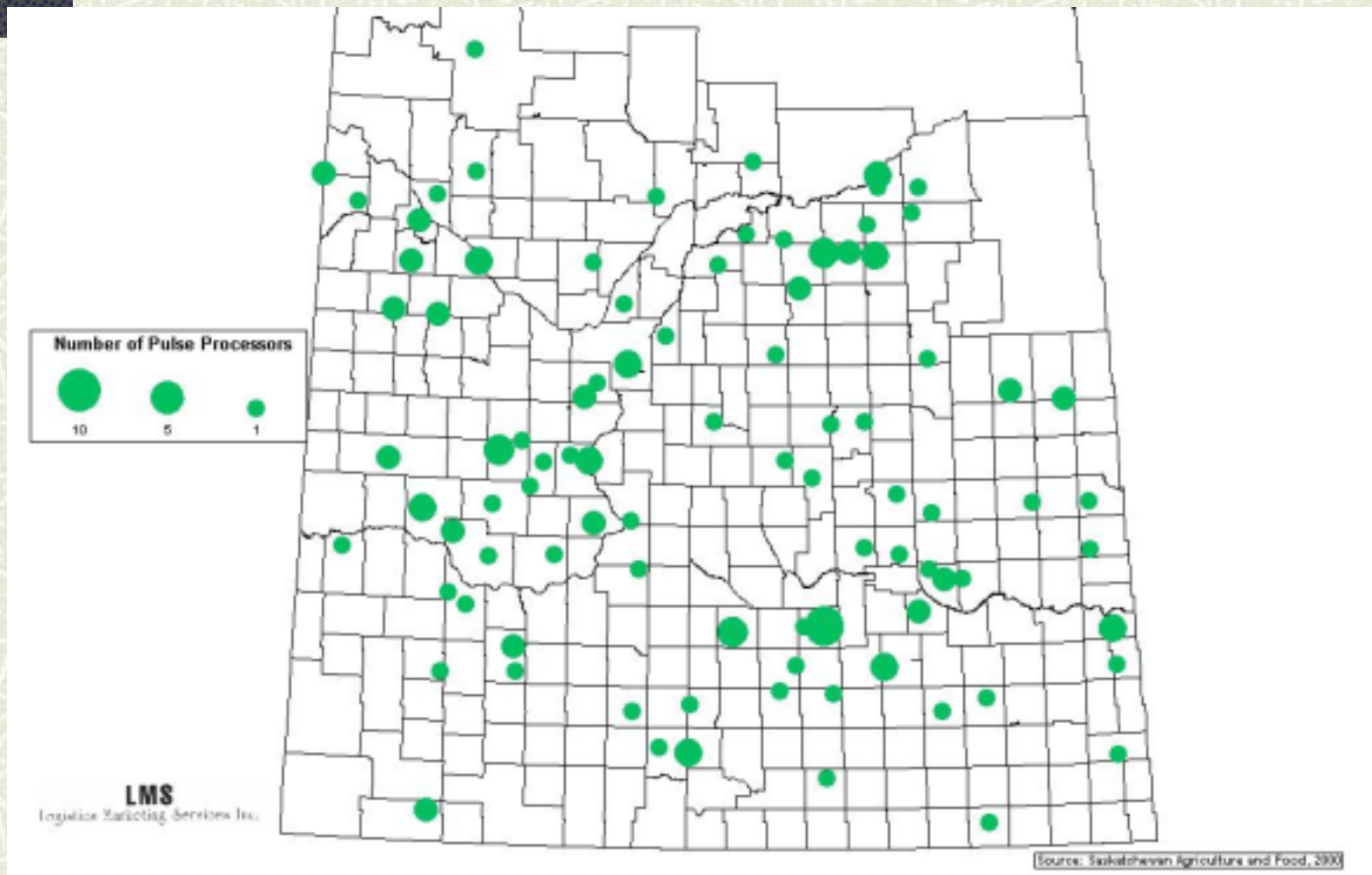

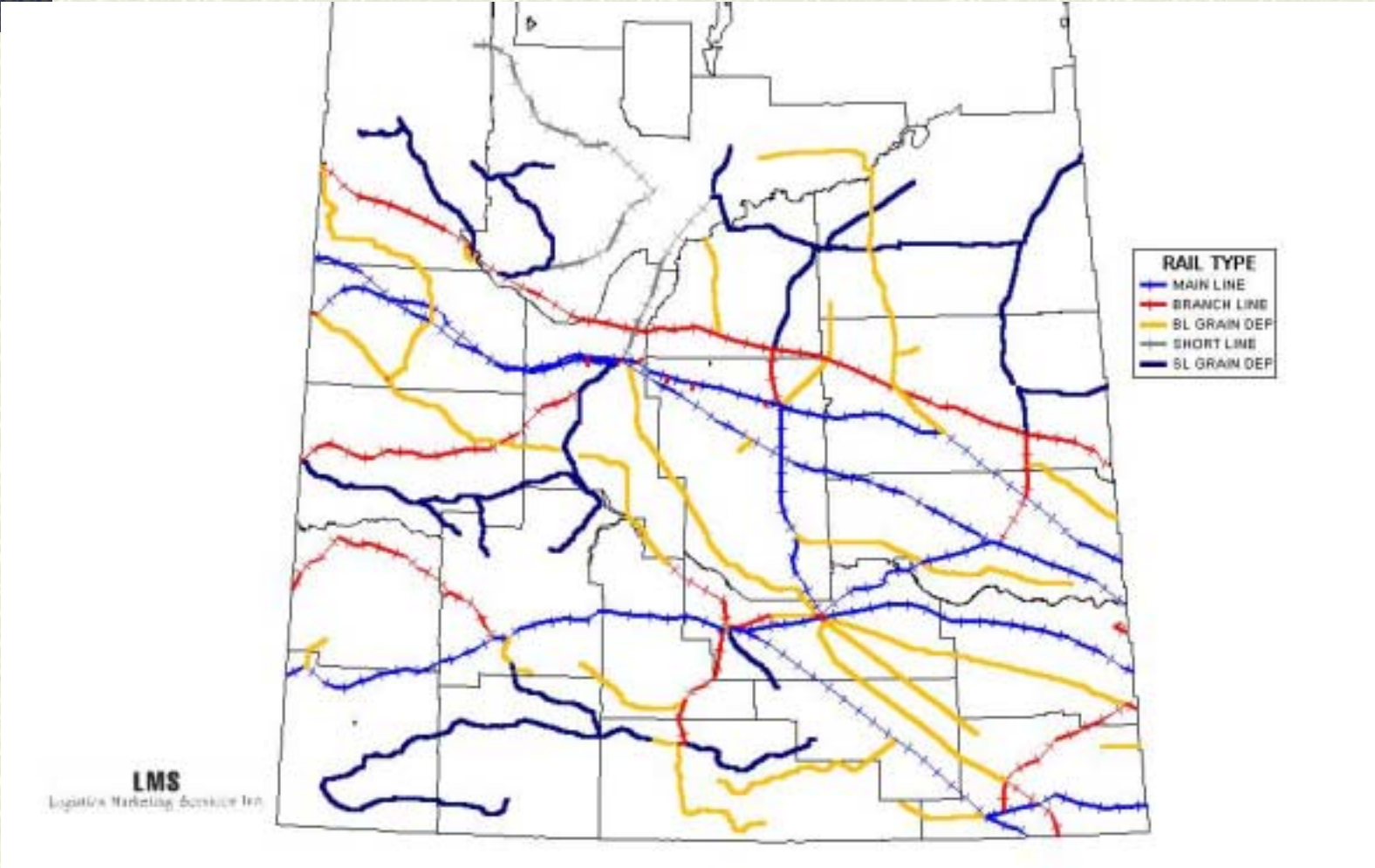

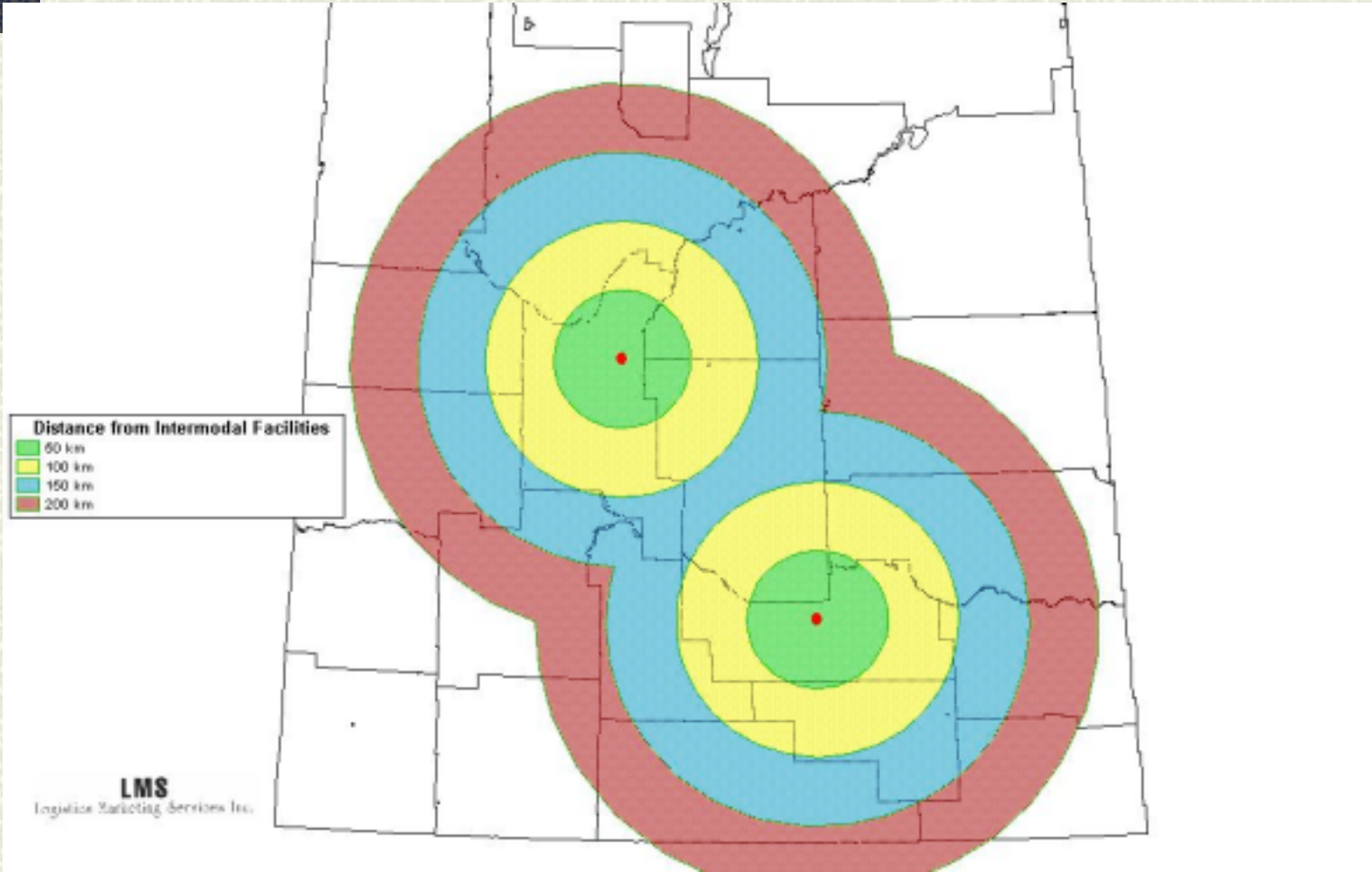

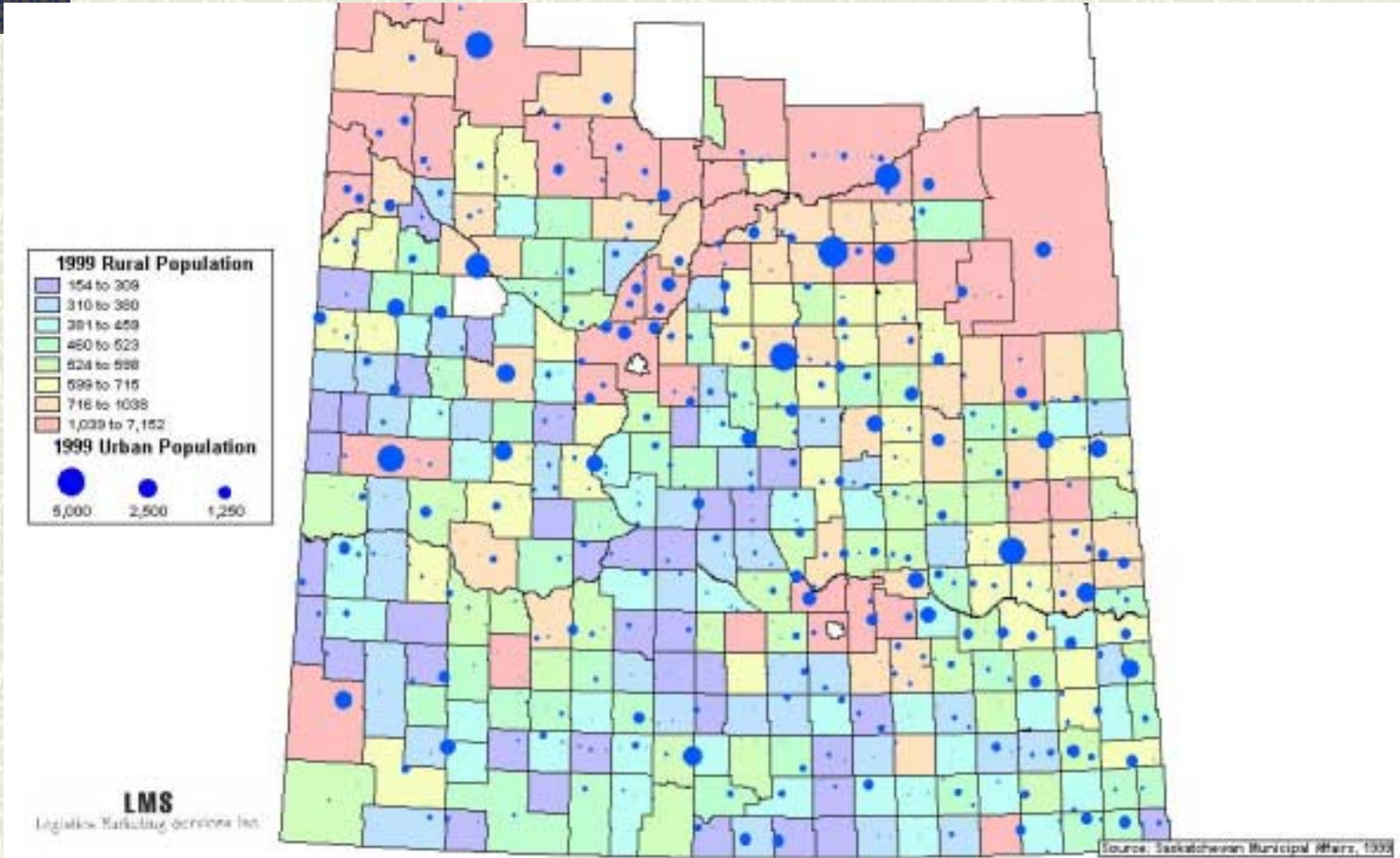

Distance to Intermodal Sites



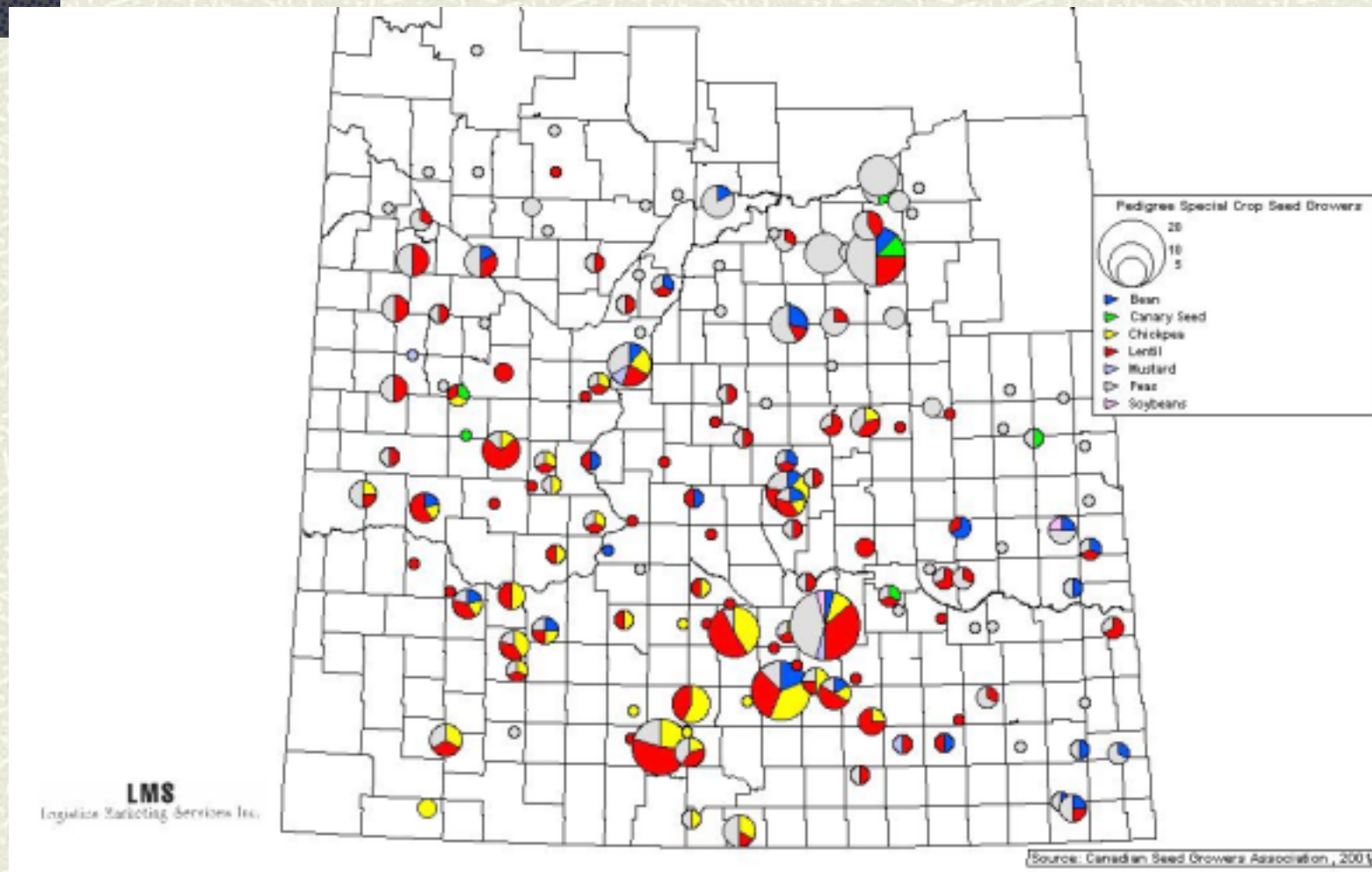
